
The purpose of this document is to show you what you can expect should you choose to invest in this issue of the 0-hr Armada Codex. This issue presents three smaller ships: the Morgana torpedo boat, Ferrum Quaesitor mining ship, and Iroquois dropship.


The product consists of a main book, map pages book, and uncut map images. Specifically, this is what is shown in this brief demo document:

## • Page 2: Main Book, Map Book, Map Images

- An overview of the ships, components, and statistics is provided. Generic ratings and Starfinder stats are provided. Each area of each vessel is enumerated and described. Rendered images are included throughout.
- The map book provides tactical maps (1 inch = 5
  ft.) for the interior areas of the ships. The pages are designed to be printed out and laid edge to edge. Layers are used so that certain map elements (like the grid, cargo, or the black and white version of the map) may be toggled on and off as desired.
- Complete deckplans are presented in a single giant image, layered so that the grid, black and white version, and so on can be toggled on or off. It includes a light background good for printing, and a dark background good for display on a computer or with a projector. Single layer jpeg images are also included for easy VTT use.
- **Page 3:** This is a sample page from the map book. The layers are live in this demo document.
- **Page 4:** Displayed here is a sample of some rendered art from the main book.
- **Page 5:** This is a copy of the product overview from the sales web page.

Thank you for taking the time to explore this product line. I hope that these ships can find a place in your fleet!







## 0-hr Armada Codex

## **Retro Pack**

This issue of the Codex presents a set of small ships to help bring your campaign to life. Specifically, this retro sci-fi collection presents two rockets: a classic tail lander and a more futuristic horizontal option; plus a single-pilot UFO and a larger flying saucer.

The **V7-A** is a classic tail-landing atomic-powered rocket with a crew of four. It has six levels, wingtip lasers, and a detachable command capsule for emergencies.

Rocketship **X-84** is laid out horizontally, like an aircraft with two decks. It also carries a crew of four. This one is armed with a turret on top and features a singularity core and stardrive for propulsion.


The backbone of the alien force is the **Class 5 Flying Saucer**. Similar in size to the human rockets but with the classic disc shape, it has a crew of five, dimensional displacement drive, transporter beam, and disintegration ray. It's also equipped with a lab, examination room, and holding cell for choice specimens.

The **Type 2 UFO** is the alien version of a fighter craft: a small, maneuverable ship that carries a single pilot and is armed with a disintegration beam.

The Retro Pack contains three highly detailed, layered PDF files:

- Main Book
  - 25 page PDF file detailing the interior areas of the ships and their capabilities.
  - Contains 3D rendered scenes as well as orthographic views.
  - Background, art, and text are on different layers for custom display and printing.
- Map Pages
  - 24 page PDF file containing complete interior maps at 1 inch = 5 foot scale.
  - Divided into pages for easy printing in full color or printer-friendly black and white.
  - Selectable layers include a 1-inch grid, black & white version, and optional cargo.
- Uncut Map Images
  - Three layered PDF files containing large, uncut images of the deckplans.
  - Includes 11x21, 7x25, and 18x20 inch images of the X-84, V7-A, and Flying Saucers respectively.
  - Text-free jpeg images, grid-aligned, on a dark background are provided for VTT use.
- Starfinder Statistics
  - Custom Starfinder stat sheets are provided for all four ships.
    - V7-A: a tier 2 small (vertical) rocket
    - X-84: a tier 2 small rocketship
    - Class 5: a tier 9 small flying saucer
    - Type 2: a tier 5 tiny UFO
